LIFE LAUNCH LICENSING AGREEMENT

All strategic partners are required to pay a one-time licensing fee. This fee allows for the utilization of all Life Launch program material processes, and technology within the partner's context. It also pursues the care of Stand in the Gap for the successful launch, integration, and operation of the Life Launch Mentor methodology of care in their context. This does not mean the partner owns the Life Launch material, but rather, is paying for it's utilization for the sake of their subjective context. Strategic partners reserve the right to modify material as needed to support the proper integration of Life Launch into their context, upon approval of your partner care staff.

The Life Launch licensing product material and methodology should not be shared or given to organizations outside of the context of the licensed partner.

All partners are required to strictly follow and adhere to all systems, processes, and methodologies required to operate the Life Launch mentor program as Stand in the Gap Ministries sees fit. Choosing to operate Life Launch in any other manner than that which has been deemed proper by Stand in the Gap staff could result in the termination of the strategic partnership. Failure to adhere to the nonnegotiable partner expectations could also lead to the termination of the strategic partnership.

Both parties reserve the right to terminate this licensing agreement at any time. If the strategic partner seeks to terminate the partnership, they will forfeit the ability to utilize any systems, processes, material, brands, logos, assimilation processes, or anything that pertains to the proprietary structure and nature of the Life Launch mentor program and methodology within their context.

STRATEGIC PARTNER EXPECTATIONS

- All active mentors must be active in a local church, or confirm that they are from the Christian community.
- All strategic partners are required to strictly follow all processes, systems, and methodologies required to correctly operate the Life Launch mentor program. Small contextual modifications and changes can be made under the supervision and approval of your Stand in the Gap care staff.
- All strategic partners must designate a current staff member as the Program Manager of Life Launch in their context.
- All strategic partners and designated program managers are required to promptly respond and interact with SITGM care staff every month.
